The Clinical Course of Internal Medicine – CCIM is the greatest event of the Chapter of Patras of the Scientific Society of Hellenic Medical Students – SSHMS. The first Course was held the 27-28 of September, 2014, in the Conference Hall of Agora Argiri in Patras. Now, after four consecutive years in which the Course is held, it has been established as the most significant event of our Chapter.

The Basic Life Support—BLS and the use of Automated External Defibrillator—AED are the first level for the care of a victim of cardiac arrest. In this ERC BLS/AED Provider Course, qualified instructors will lead and support you during the educational procedure.

The content of this course includes: the direct recognition of a patient in danger, the activation of the first aid system, the CPR, the right position of the patient and the first aid in case of choking.

The AEDs are often available in Europe. This course includes the education in use of an AED.

The BLS is vital in all cases of cardiopulmonary resuscitation. The possession of a BLS recognition is necessary for participating in any other courses which are approved by ERC.

All the participants will receive the Certificate of Attendance approved by the ERC.

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2. Basic Rescuer Training

This Workshop consists of three main parts, each one is a skill necessary for a rescuer, prehospital care provider.

At the beginning, the participants will learn what they have to do in case of emergency, when there is a victim. The main aim is the security of the place of the accident, of the rescuers, of the witnesses and of the victim.

Moreover, the participants will be informed about how they can activate correctly the emergency mechanism via the correct and full call for help.

After these steps, when the participants will already have understood the manner of thinking of a rescuer, they will practice in the maneuver of Rautek. This maneuver permits to the rescuer to move unconscious victims from regions of high danger using the minimum effort, regardless of their physical characteristics.
