

22nd MEDICAL OLYMPICS



The Committee of the 22nd Medical Olympics and the Organizing Committee of the 24th SCHMS gladly invite you to participate and test yourselves and your knowledge in the only competition of medical knowledge for undergraduate students in Greece! The Medical Olympics is a competition of medical knowledge and critical thinking, which covers the entire spectrum of medical science, at a student level. It is addressed to undergraduate students of biomedical sciences, from every country. The Medical Olympics is an established part of the Scientific Conference of Hellenic Medical Students (SCHMS) the last 21 years.

This year, the 22nd Medical Olympics is organized as part of the

24th SCHMS and the 12th International Forum.

Its prime objective is to promote and reward medical knowledge of medical students, by enhancing teamwork and through the exchange of views among the participants. The Medical Olympics aim at recreating the cooperation among all the medical specialties and biosciences, where everybody will be called to manage clinical problems in practice.

The Medical Olympics consist of two different competitions:

- The Olympiad of Preclinical Knowledge, which includes questions of basic biomedical sciences
- The Olympiad of Clinical Knowledge, which includes clinical cases concerning every surgical and medical specialty, and this year is comprised of both a written part and live clinical scenarios.

The selection of the questions will be appointed to the Scientific Committee of the Medical Olympics, which consists of the teaching staff of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and consultants of the Greek National Healthcare System.

Anyone who is interested can participate either individually or in a group (of up to 3 students), in both competitions.

This year, as also in the past versions, we try to upgrade the quality of the competition and widen the eligibility criteria for participation. This is the first Olympics where the ability to choose between English and Greek as the language of the examination is provided, so that the competition can be more accessible to our colleagues from abroad. Furthermore, during the Olympiad of Clinical Knowledge, a second phase is included for the first time, where students will test their skills on clinical scenarios.

Eligible to participate in the 22nd Medical Olympics are undergraduate students from every biomedical department, coming from any country. The participation in the Olympics is covered within the basic registration to the Congress. The members of the Organizing Committee of the Olympics, as well as any other person involved with the Organizing Committee of the Congress in any other way, are not allowed to participate.

Prizes will be awarded to the teams of the three first places for both competitions, according to the score they will achieve. The announcement of the results as well as the awards ceremony will take place at the Closing Ceremony of the Congress.

AWARDS

The 24th Scientific Conference of Hellenic Medical Students includes three types of awards.

The main goals of the award process are the following:

- a fair evaluation of the papers with transparency and objectivity, via an analytical evaluation system
- to promote all participants' efforts by presenting the detailed score of both the distinguished and the unselected papers
- to enhance cooperation, through participation in the evaluation process of teachers and students from all seven Hellenic Medical Universities
- taking the oral presentation into consideration by introducing the session of the oral presentations submitted for awards to the scientific program
- the ecumenical meeting of medical specialties, via presence in the evaluation committee professors from all the major specialties
- and finally, the worthy promotion of the best oral presentation, which not only will fully represent the scientific, social and educational orientation of the Scientific Conference of Hellenic Medical Students but also will harken to the pulse of research developments.

More specifically, at the core of this year's awards is the "Ars Medica" award. It is the award of the best oral presentation and constitutes an established institution, which is evolving alongside the conference, and aims at promoting the noble competition and the discovery of promising future medical fields, while, at the same time, urges students and young doctors to contemplate, to cooperate and ultimately to improve. Although for several years the prizegiving process is part of the conference, last year, for the first time, a new system for best oral presentation's excellence was introduced. In the context of consecutive improvement and modernization of the awards ceremony, this year, at the 24th Scientific Conference of Hellenic Medical Students, we follow the suggestion of our fellow students and further develop the evaluation system of the oral presentations submitted for awards. The institution of the best oral presentation award, through the promotion of all the mentioned principles, especially the equal consideration of all branches of Medicine, and through the promotion of Research's fundamental principles, is transformed into a revival of "Ars Medica", viz. "Art Medicine", as expressed by the great doctor of antiquity, Claudius Galinos, in his homonymous book.
